in Nampula (districts of Nacaroa, Ilha de Mozambique, Nacala Porto) and Niassa Province (districts of Cuamba and Lichinga).

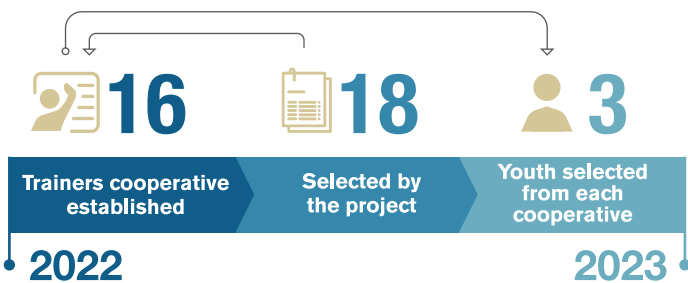

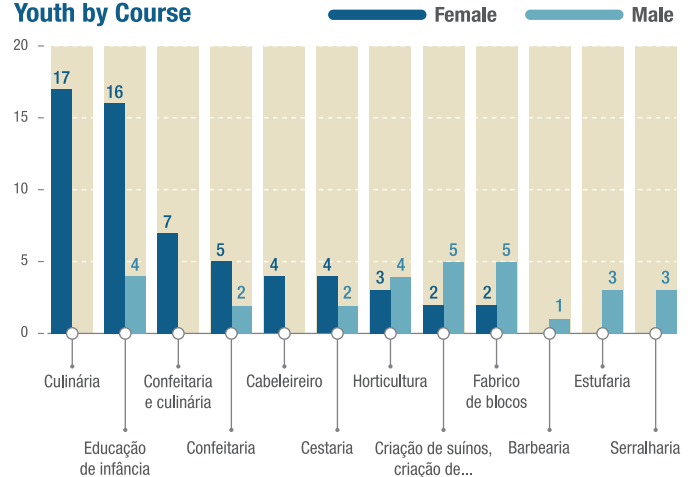
DEMOGRAPHY OF THE SAMPLE POPULATION

The satisfaction survey was conducted interviewing 89 youth and 16 trainer providers.



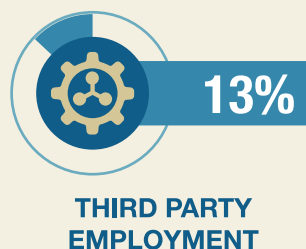
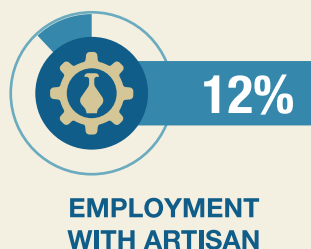
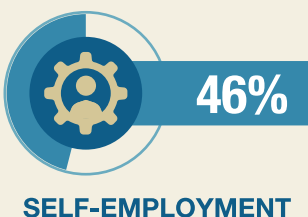

Youth by Course

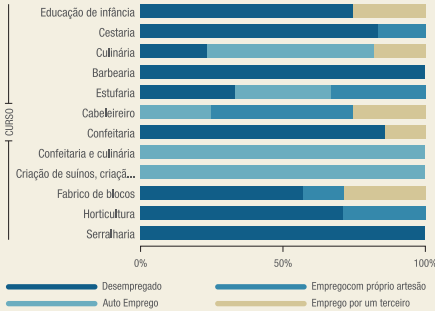

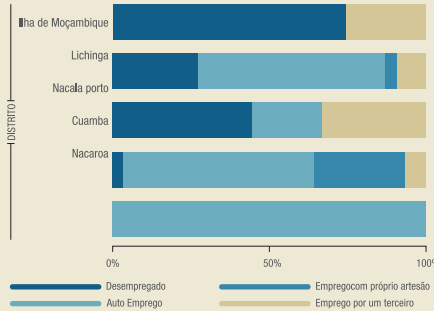

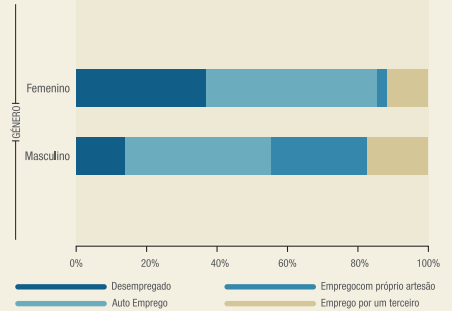
Employment By Course



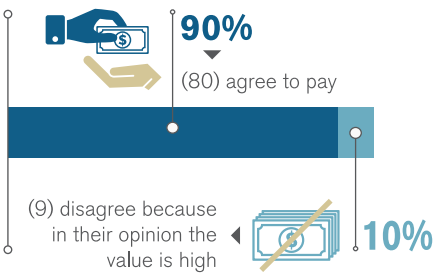
Employment By District



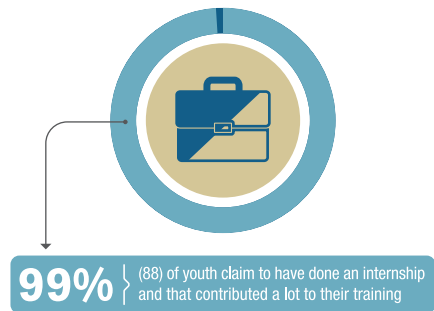
Employment By Gender



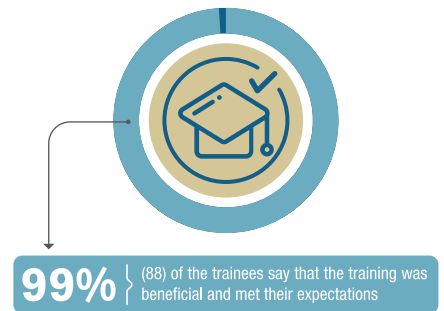

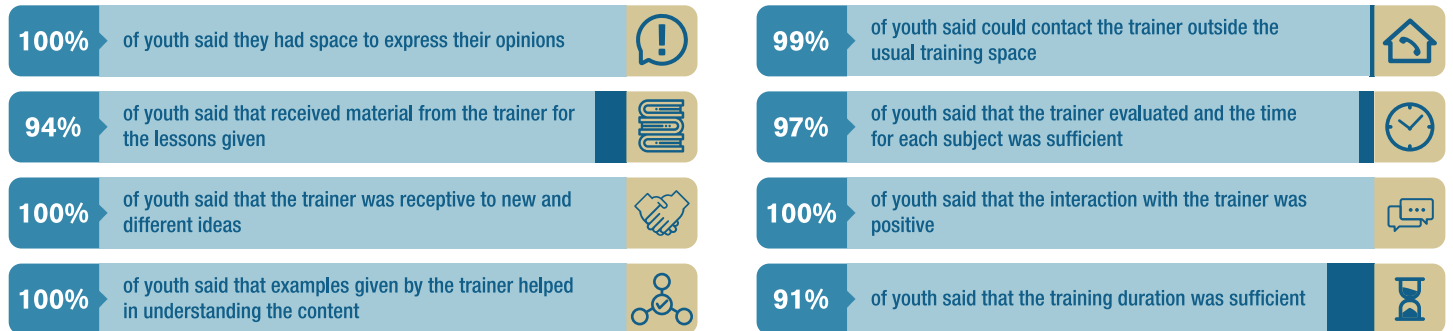
INTERNSHIP STAGE



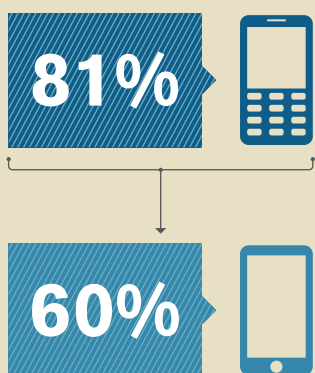

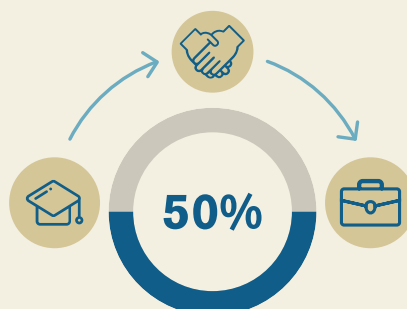
